REPORT ON COMMUNITY SURVEY PROJECT -2024-25

As part of the prescribed undergraduate curriculum, the Department of History, Government Degree College (A), Rampachodavaram, successfully facilitated the **Community Service Project (CSP)** for **II Semester B.A. History students** from **8th May 2025 to 8th June 2025**. The project aimed to provide experiential learning through direct community engagement and socio-economic survey work.

The project was conducted under the able mentorship of **Ms. J.S. Suneetha Kumari**, Lecturer in History. Students posted their data and findings on the official **CSP portal** as per the academic requirements.

Project Themes

Methodology

- **Socio-Economic Surveys** were conducted by students in nearby rural and tribal communities to collect primary data.
- Each student conducted interviews, household surveys, and field observations relevant to their selected topic.
- Students documented social conditions, challenges, and opportunities related to the themes.
- All data was **uploaded on the CSP portal** as per state guidelines.

Mentoring and Monitoring

- Regular reviews and guidance were provided by the mentor, **Ms. J.S. Suneetha Kumari**.
- Weekly presentations and progress discussions were held to ensure quality and direction.
- Students received support in preparing questionnaires, conducting interviews, and writing reports.

Evaluation and Viva-Voce

- The **final viva-voce and evaluation** of the Community Service Project was conducted by the **Internal Evaluation Committee** on **18th July 2025**.
- Each student presented their findings, methodologies, and community engagement experience during the evaluation.
